

Limmud returns to Glasgow

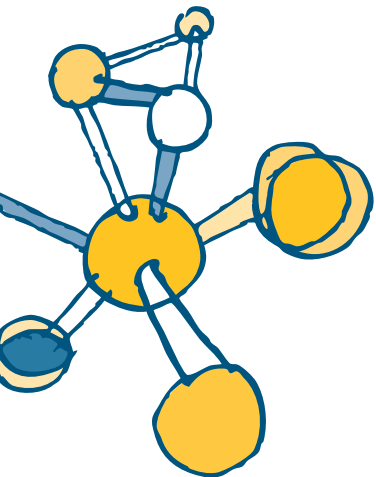


Welcome to Limmud
